1	AN ACT relating to financial disclosures of postsecondary education institutions.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 164 IS CREATED TO
4	READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	(1) (a) No later than June 30 of each year, the president or chief executive officer
6	of each state institution or independent institution that is licensed or
7	overseen by the Council on Postsecondary Education, and the chair of the
8	governing board of each institution, shall jointly execute a signed, sworn
9	statement attesting to whether the institution:
10	1. Was in sound financial standing with a stable financial base to
11	support the mission of the institution and the scope of its programs
12	and services during the previous fiscal year;
13	2. Underwent an institutional audit for the most recent fiscal year
14	prepared by an independent certified public accountant or appropriate
15	government auditing agency employing the appropriate audit guide
16	during the previous fiscal year; and
17	3. Has an annual budget for the upcoming fiscal year that is preceded by
18	sound planning, subject to sound fiscal procedures, and approved by
19	the president of the institution and the chair of the governing board.
20	(b) In executing the statement required by paragraph (a) of this subsection, a
21	president or chief executive officer and chair of the governing board of an
22	institution may reasonably rely upon the representations of an employee of
23	the institution that is responsible for the financial management and
24	accounting of the institution, including the treasurer or chief financial
25	officer of the institution, and external financial service providers.
26	(2) Each institution shall provide the sworn statement required by subsection (1) of
27	this section to the president of the Council on Postsecondary Education, the

1		chairs of the Budget Review Subcommittee on Education of the Interim Joint
2		Committee on Appropriations and Revenue, and the co-chairs of the Interim
3		Joint Committee on Appropriations and Revenue.
4	<u>(3)</u>	If an institution fails to provide a statement as required by subsection (2) of this
5		section, the Council on Postsecondary Education shall have the authority to
6		conduct an investigation and request any financial documentation necessary to
7		inform a report on the financial data required by subsection (1) of this section.
8		The council shall report its findings to the chairs of the Budget Review
9		Subcommittee on Education of the Interim Joint Committee on Appropriations
10		and Revenue and the co-chairs of the Interim Joint Committee on Appropriations
11		and Revenue.
