- 2 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
- 3 → SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 21A IS CREATED TO
- 4 READ AS FOLLOWS:
- 5 (1) The Supreme Court has power to provide for the organization, governance, and
- 6 membership of the bar of Kentucky, and to adopt rules and regulations to govern
- 7 the conduct and activity of the bar and its members, except that no member of the
- 8 bar, without the member's annual written consent, shall be required to join or pay
- 9 <u>membership dues to any association or entity beyond payment of fees required to</u>
- 10 <u>support the costs associated with:</u>
- 11 (a) Admission to the bar; and
- 12 (b) Discipline of members of the bar.
- 13 (2) For purposes of this section, a member of the bar is any attorney licensed to
- 14 practice law in Kentucky.
- Section 2. KRS 21A.300 is amended to read as follows:
- 16 (1) Notwithstanding <u>Section 1 of this Act</u>[KRS 21A.160], for a period of thirty (30)
- days following the filing of a criminal or civil action, or claim for damages, or a
- traffic citation, injury, accident, or disaster, an attorney or an attorney referral
- service shall be subject to the following prohibition. An attorney or an attorney
- 20 referral service shall not directly solicit, or knowingly permit another person to
- 21 directly solicit on his or its behalf, a victim of the accident or disaster, or a relative
- of the victim, for the purpose of obtaining professional employment relating to a
- criminal or civil action, or claim for damages, arising out of the traffic citation,
- injury, accident, or disaster.
- 25 (2) Notwithstanding Section 1 of this Act[KRS 21A.160], an attorney shall not
- 26 knowingly accept a referral from an attorney referral service when that referral has
- 27 resulted from the attorney referral service violating the prohibition established in

- 1 subsection (1) of this section.
- 2 Section 3. KRS 21A.310 is amended to read as follows:
- 3 (1) Notwithstanding Section 1 of this Act[KRS 21A.160], any person violating any
- 4 provision of KRS 21A.300 shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a Class A
- 5 misdemeanor.
- 6 (2) The Kentucky Supreme Court may discipline any attorney who violates any
- 7 provision of KRS 21A.300.
- 8 (3) A penalty may be imposed on an attorney pursuant to subsection (1) of this section,
- 9 subsection (2) of this section, or both subsections.
