2018 Regular Session of the General Assembly

Enacted legislation relating to the Capital Planning Advisory Board

Senate Bill 61 (Senator Chris McDaniel) This bill would authorize and appropriate \$12.5 million other funds and \$2 million restricted funds in FY 2017-18 for the restoration of J.H. Richmond Residential Hall at Murray State University. Emergency clause.

Senate Bill 70 (*Senator Chris McDaniel*) Authorize and appropriate \$8,000,000 for the construction of a television broadcast/production studio at the University of Louisville. Emergency clause.

Senate Bill 86 (Senator Stan Humphries) The bill would increase capital construction and information technology project thresholds for executive branch agencies from \$600,000 to \$1,000,000. The thresholds will match the current capital project thresholds for postsecondary institutions.

Senate Bill 129 (Senator Jared Carpenter) This bill would change the name of the Department for Energy Development and Independence to the Office of Energy Policy, and change the name of the Kentucky State Nature Preserves Commission to the Office of Kentucky Nature Preserves.

Senate Bill 200 (Senator Robert Stivers) The bill would allow the Kentucky Communications Network Authority, with the approval of its board, to incur debt in an amount up to \$110,000,000. Requires reporting to the Capital Projects and Bond Oversight Committee and the Legislative Research Commission.

Senate Bill 203 (Senator Max Wise) Amend KRS 45A.077 to suspend the requirement for General Assembly approval for public-private partnership projects contracted for projects publicized prior to July 1, 2020.

House Bill 200 (*Representative Steven Rudy*) AN ACT relating to appropriations and revenue measures providing financing and conditions for the operations, maintenance, support, and functioning of the government of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

House Bill 201 (*Representative Steven Rudy*) AN ACT relating to appropriations providing financing and conditions for the operations, maintenance, support, and functioning of the Transportation Cabinet of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

House Bill 203 (*Representative Steven Rudy*) AN ACT making appropriations for the operations, maintenance, support, and functioning of the Judicial Branch of the government of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

House Bill 204 (*Representative Steven Rudy*) AN ACT making appropriations for the operations, maintenance, and support of the Legislative Branch of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

House Bill 264 (*Representative Matt Castlen*) AN ACT relating to reorganizations. Amend KRS 12.020, 12.252, 224.10-020, 336.015, and 336.020 to abolish the Office of General Administration and Program Support (GAPS) for Shared Services and all of its divisions and abolish the Office of Inspector General for Shared Services for the Energy and Environmental Cabinet, Labor Cabinet, and Public Protection Cabinet, and create new offices and divisions within each cabinet to handle the services previously handled by GAPS.

House Resolution 337 (*Representative David Osborne and others*) Urges the 2018 Program Review and Investigations Committee to investigate the KentuckyWired Project.
