Current Projects

- Currently 21 projects underway including:
- Campus Master Plan scheduled to be complete Fall 2023
- Roofing Pool \$5M appropriation in 2021-2022 Budget
 - Completed three roofs Exum, Blazer and Carver
 - Remaining funds under contract by fall Jordan Building, Betty White and The Halls
- Asset Preservation Projects
 - Hume Hall repairs water infiltration issues
 - Parking Lot repairs
 - Residence Halls renovation study
 - Elevator repairs, modernization and replacement
 - Walkway Improvements
 - Various Demolition projects



Future Projects


- Asset Preservation Projects
 - Jackson Hall renovation partially funded with federal grant
 - Residence Halls renovations based on recommendations from consultants
 - Exum Center renovations
 - Future phase(s) of walkway improvements project




Immediate Needs for Funding

- Years of deferred maintenance have left buildings in despair
 - Campus wide window project failing windows are creating water infiltration issues as well as energy loss
 - Walkway repairs first phase underway to address emergent issues, but will need future projects to address all safety concerns
 - MEP upgrades most buildings still have original infrastructure. Failures continue to create distractions to the learning environment
 - Continue roof replacements

2024-2030 CAPITAL PLAN OVERVIEW

- New Health Science Facility University's Number One Priority
 - Currently housed in 50+ year old facility, which was the original campus infirmary
 - Lack of adequate teaching and learning space has been a barrier for advancing the program needs for clinical research and education
 - A new facility would allow the program to achieve its potential by having multipurpose and functional building that includes lab space, learning lab configured as a virtual hospital with high-fidelity simulators, debriefing rooms, as well as may other opportunities



2024-2030 CAPITAL PLAN OVERVIEW

Upgrading Residential Housing Facilities

- Currently in procurement process to hire a design team to evaluate, budget and prioritize most urgent needs for facilities
- Focus will be on correcting years of deferred maintenance in these facilities. This will include correcting the problem but also repairing the damage that has been caused.
