2026 General Fund Priority Requests Emergency Veterinary & Teaching Clinic

- School of Veterinary Medicine Program should be presented to CPE for approval in January 2026
- Private gift of >\$4M to support the program
- MSU Foundation support of \$2.5M
 - MSU is not asking the General Assembly for start up funding for the School of Veterinary Medicine Program.
- Emergency teaching clinic recommended by practicing veterinarians to support their needs during evenings and weekends
 - This is not required for CPE program approval
- Provide after hours emergency care for the State (value added approach)
- Fully functional, state-of-the-art clinical facility to replicate actual practice


2026 General Fund Priority Requests University of Louisville Medical Sciences Partnership Building

- Partnership with the University of Louisville (UofL)
- Construction the Medical Sciences Building at Murray State
- Obtain 2+2 UofL medical school presence in Murray
- Assist with the rural healthcare shortage in the region and state
- Funding for the construction of the facility and needed medical teaching equipment

- Planned new construction on the Murray State West Farm
- Planned occupancy in August 2027





State-Funded Projects Update

Learning Commons w/Housing Currently in design – Phase C

\$38,000,000

- Planned new construction in the North main residential campus
- 83,370 SF Student Success areas, dining amenities, and 254 beds
 - Study rooms, meeting rooms, large classroom (120 people)
- Planned occupancy in August 2027
