

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION designating the Representative John "Bam" Carney
2 Memorial Highway in Taylor County.

3 WHEREAS, from time to time, the General Assembly has seen fit to honor various
4 Kentuckians by naming portions of state highways and erecting commemorative roadway
5 signs in their honor; and

6 WHEREAS, these Kentuckians have come from all walks of life, held a multitude
7 of jobs, and had a variety of accomplishments that made them deserving of the honor;
8 and

9 WHEREAS, these individuals have included former Governors, former members of
10 the General Assembly, decorated veterans, slain law enforcement officers, local elected
11 officials, astronauts, doctors, educators, distinguished athletes, and civic leaders; and

12 WHEREAS, every citizen of the Commonwealth owes a great debt of gratitude to
13 the patriotic men and women killed and wounded in service to their country in times of
14 great need; and

15 WHEREAS, the General Assembly has often honored the veterans of this state by
16 naming portions of several roads, from interstates to small two-lane country roads, in
17 their honor; and

18 WHEREAS, the General Assembly again sees fit to honor a group of individuals
19 who have made the lives of their fellow Kentuckians better and brought honor and
20 respect to the Commonwealth;

21 NOW, THEREFORE,

22 ***Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

23 ➔Section 1. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate the completed portion of
24 the Campbellsville Bypass (Kentucky Route 55), from the intersection with Kentucky
25 Route 201 to the intersection with Kentucky Route 70, as the "Representative John
26 "Bam" Carney Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this
27 Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.

1 ➔Section 2. Upon its eventual completion, the Transportation Cabinet shall
2 continue the designation of the "Representative John "Bam" Carney Memorial Highway"
3 on the portion of the Campbellsville Bypass (Kentucky Route 55), from the intersection
4 with Kentucky Route 70 to the intersection with United States Route 68, and shall, within
5 30 days of the completion of construction, erect appropriate signage denoting this
6 designation.

7 ➔Section 3. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate Kentucky Route 1057, in
8 Powell County, from the intersection with Frames Branch Road, and ending at the
9 intersection with Daniel's Branch Road, as the "Rondal Winslow Davis Memorial
10 Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution, erect
11 appropriate signs denoting this designation.

12 ➔Section 4. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate Kentucky Route 345 in
13 Christian County, from its start at the state line with Tennessee to the intersection with
14 Kentucky Route 107, as "The Gold Star Families Memorial Highway" and shall, within
15 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution, erect appropriate signs denoting this
16 designation.

17 ➔Section 5. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate the bridge on Kentucky
18 Route 114 over Levisa Fork in Floyd County (Bridges #036B0084R and #036B0084L) as
19 the "Heroes Bridge" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution,
20 erect appropriate signs denoting this designation. The signs erected under this section
21 shall read:

22 "Heroes Bridge

23 In Memory of Our Fallen Officers

24 Jacob Chaffins, Ralph Frasure, William Petry, and K-9 Drago".

25 ➔Section 6. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate a portion of Kentucky
26 Route 111 in Fleming County, from its intersection with Hot Shot Road to its intersection
27 with Saunders Lane, as the "Private Dennie Lee Story Memorial Highway" and shall,

1 within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution, erect signage denoting this
2 designation.

3 ➔Section 7. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate Kentucky Route 878 in
4 Ohio County, from the beginning of Kentucky Route 878, from Kentucky Route 69 at
5 mile point 0 to mile point 7.485 at the Ohio/Grayson County line, as the "Pvt. Millard R.
6 Hurt Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this
7 Resolution, erect the appropriate signage.

8 ➔Section 8. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate Kentucky Route 2275 in
9 Johnson County, from its intersection with Kentucky Route 40 until its intersection with
10 Marina Road, as the "Sheriff Gene Cyrus Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days
11 of the effective date of this Resolution, erect the appropriate signage.

12 ➔Section 9. The Transportation Cabinet shall honor the accomplishments of
13 Marvin Rose by including him on the Country Music Highway on United States Highway
14 23 in Lawrence County, and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution,
15 erect appropriate signs denoting this designation.

16 ➔Section 10. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate Kentucky Route 467 in
17 Grant County, from its intersection with Kentucky Route 22 to its intersection with
18 Clark's Creek Road, as the "Greg "Slim" Hearn Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30
19 days of the effective date of this Resolution, erect signage denoting this designation.

20 ➔Section 11. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate the entire length of
21 Kentucky Route 181 in Muhlenberg County as the "Muhlenberg County Veterans
22 Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution,
23 erect appropriate signs denoting the designation. This designation shall supersede any
24 previous designation of a state highway as the Muhlenberg County Veterans Highway.

25 ➔Section 12. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate the entire length of
26 Kentucky Route 181 in Todd County as the "Todd County Veterans Memorial Highway"
27 and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution, erect appropriate signs

1 denoting the designation.

2 ➔Section 13. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate Kentucky Route 1107 in
3 Johnson County, from the intersection with Kentucky Route 321 to the intersection with
4 Kentucky Route 302, as the "Tim Barker Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days
5 of the effective date of this Resolution, erect appropriate signs denoting this designation.

6 ➔Section 14. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate the bridge at the
7 junction of Kentucky Route 1165 and Kentucky Route 1166 in Perry County (Bridge
8 Number 097B000141N) in honor of Corporal James "Jim" Caudill and shall, within 30
9 days of the effective date of this Resolution, erect signs denoting this designation:

10 "Cpl. James "Jim" Caudill Memorial Bridge
11 Purple Heart with Oak Leaf Cluster Recipient".

12 ➔Section 15. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate Kentucky Route 1933 in
13 Breathitt County as the "Emanuel C. Taylor Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30
14 days of the effective date of this Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this
15 designation.

16 ➔Section 16. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate United States Route 25
17 in Madison County, from mile point 9.565 to mile point 15.442, as the "Sheriff Cecil
18 "Dude" Cochran Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of
19 this Resolution, erect appropriate signs denoting this designation.

20 ➔Section 17. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate Kentucky Route 190 in
21 Bell County, from mile point 12 to mile point 17.628, as the "Nick Grubbs Memorial
22 Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution, erect
23 appropriate signs denoting this designation.

24 ➔Section 18. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate Kentucky Route 160 in
25 Harlan County, from mile point 6.357 to mile point 6.998, as the "PFC Edward Harper
26 Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution,
27 erect appropriate signs denoting this designation.

1 ➔Section 19. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate Berea Bypass currently
2 under construction (Six Year Plan Project ID # 192-2000) as the "Mayor C.C. Hensley
3 Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the completion of the highway, erect
4 appropriate signs denoting this designation.

5 ➔Section 20. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate the bridge on Kentucky
6 Route 3680 at the Harold/Minnie Connector in Floyd County as the "Curly Moore
7 Memorial Bridge" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution, erect
8 signs denoting this designation.

9 ➔Section 21. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate the bridge on United
10 States Route 62 in Nelson County at mile point 2.69 (Bridge #090B00060N) as the "John
11 W. "Hawk" Cissel, Jr. Memorial Bridge" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of
12 this Resolution, erect appropriate signs denoting this designation.

13 ➔Section 22. The Transportation Cabinet shall honor the accomplishments of
14 Corbet "Cuddles" Newsome by including him on the Country Music Highway on United
15 States Highway 23 in Pike County and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this
16 Resolution, erect appropriate signs denoting this designation.

17 ➔Section 23. The Transportation Cabinet shall honor the accomplishments of
18 Roger Lee Coleman II by including him on the Country Music Highway on United States
19 Highway 23 in Pike County, near exit 15, and shall, within 30 days of the effective date
20 of this Resolution, erect appropriate signs denoting this designation.

21 ➔Section 24. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate the bridge on Kentucky
22 Route 1789 at mile point 0.35 in Pike County (Bridge #098B00053N) as the "Willie
23 Runyon Memorial Bridge" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this
24 Resolution, erect signs denoting this designation.

25 ➔Section 25. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate Kentucky Route 2759 in
26 Knott County as the "Danny Terry Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the
27 effective date of this Resolution, erect appropriate signs denoting this designation.
