### Consideration of Bills

#### HB 434/CS

#### ***AN ACT relating to identity documents.***

**Sponsor:** Representative Kevin Jackson

House Bill 434 was discussed by its sponsor Representative Kevin Jackson, who indicated there was a committee substitute on the measure. Representative Josh Branscum made a motion to adopt the committee substitute. Representative Ken Upchurch seconded the motion, which passed by voice vote. Lori Hawkins Weaver, Public Affairs Manager, AAA of the Bluegrass, appeared with Representative Jackson and also spoke in favor of the measure. After brief discussion, Representative Randy Bridges made a motion to pass House Bill 434 as amended by the committee substitute. Representative Ken Upchurch seconded the motion, which passed on a 21-1-1 roll call vote.

#### SB 125

#### ***AN ACT relating to off-highway vehicles.***

**Sponsor:** Senator Phillip Wheeler

Senate Bill 125 was discussed by its sponsor Senator Phillip Wheeler. After brief discussion, Representative Josh Branscum made a motion to pass Senate Bill 125, Representative Jonathan Dixon seconded the motion, which passed on a 23-0-0 roll call vote.
