Bills for Consideration

SB 199/CS

AN ACT relating to motor vehicles and making an appropriation.

Sponsor: Senator Jimmy Higdon

Senate Bill 199 was discussed by its sponsor, Senator Jimmy Higdon, who indicated there was a committee substitute on the measure. Representative John Hodgson made a motion to adopt the committee substitute. Representative Samara Heavrin seconded the motion, which passed by voice vote. After brief discussion, Representative Jonathan Dixon made a motion to pass Senate Bill 199 as amended by the committee substitute. Representative Samara Heavrin seconded the motion, which passed on a 20-0-0 roll call vote.

SB 215

AN ACT relating to motor vehicles.
