



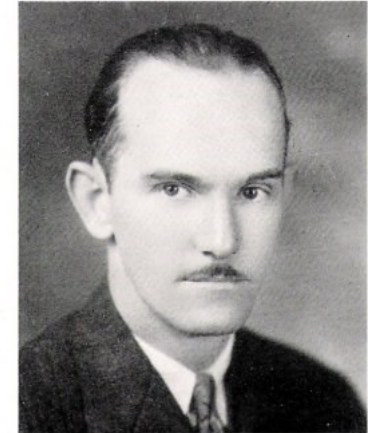
Profile: Patrick M. Payne



Hazard coach Patrick Payne took both girls' and boys' teams to the state tournament and went back home with championship titles.

In 1930, his girls' team beat Woodburn for the title, 23 to 18.

In 1932, the boys' team won the title by defeating Louisville Male in the final, 15-13, when Morton Combs, who would become a legendary coach himself, scored the winning goal. Payne is in the Dawahares KHSAA Hall of Fame.
