



Profile: Geri Grigsby



Geri Grigsby, the daughter of a basketball coach, played at McDowell High School in Floyd County. She was first team All State in 1975, 1976 and 1977, and from 1975 through 1977, had a total of 4,385 points. Her 49.8 senior season scoring average is still a state and national record, as is her 81 points in a single game (made in her junior season).

Grigsby was Miss Basketball in 1977 and Kentucky Sportswoman of the Year in 1978. She is in the National Federation of State High School Association's Hall of Fame, the Dawahares KHSAA Hall of Fame and the Kentucky High School Basketball Hall of Fame.
