



Kentucky High School Basketball Hall of Fame



There have been many outstanding high school basketball players and coaches over the past 100 years. To honor them, the Kentucky Association of Basketball Coaches decided in 2009 to start a Kentucky High School Basketball Hall of Fame.

Since 2012, the Hall of Fame has inducted 100 members, players and coaches. Its goal: to honor one person for each year of organized high school basketball by its 2017 centennial.

Until August 2017, the Hall of Fame was a virtual presence online, but that changed when the group opened a museum in the former First Presbyterian Church building in historic downtown Elizabethtown. The museum exists to preserve and display historical information and memorabilia from the first century of high school basketball, and beyond.
