

1 AN ACT making appropriations for the operations, maintenance, and support of the
 2 Legislative Branch of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

3 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:*

4 ➔Section 1. The Legislative Branch Budget is as follows:

5 **PART I**

6 **OPERATING BUDGET**

7 **Funds Appropriations:** Funds are appropriated to the Legislative Research
 8 Commission for the Legislative Branch of government out of the General Fund and
 9 Restricted Funds accounts for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2026, and ending June 30,
 10 2027, and for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2027, and ending June 30, 2028, in the
 11 following discrete sums, or so much thereof as may be necessary. Each appropriation is
 12 made by the source of respective fund or funds accounts to be used for the purposes of
 13 the Legislative Branch of government of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

21 **(1) Kentucky Legislative Ethics Commission:** Included in the above General
 22 Fund appropriation is \$567,700 in each fiscal year of the 2026-2028 fiscal biennium for
 23 the Kentucky Legislative Ethics Commission. Included in the above Restricted Funds
 24 appropriation is \$75,000 in fiscal year 2026-2027 and \$175,000 in fiscal year 2027-2028
 25 for the Kentucky Legislative Ethics Commission.

26 **(2) Kentucky Long-Term Policy Research Center:** Notwithstanding KRS
 27 7B.010 to 7B.090, operation of the Kentucky Long-Term Policy Research Center and its

1 governing board shall continue to be suspended effective July 1, 2026, and shall remain
 2 suspended for the 2026-2028 fiscal biennium or until funding is restored. No funds are
 3 appropriated for the Kentucky Long-Term Policy Research Center for fiscal year 2026-
 4 2027 and fiscal year 2027-2028.

5 **(3) Pension Benefit Increase:** Notwithstanding KRS 6.521(3), no pension
 6 benefit increase shall be granted to recipients of a retirement allowance under KRS 6.500
 7 to 6.577 on July 1, 2026.

8 **(4) Legislators Compensation:** Notwithstanding KRS 6.190 and 6.213, the daily
 9 compensation provided by KRS 6.190 and the interim expense allowance provided by
 10 KRS 6.213 for members of the General Assembly shall be as authorized by the 2024-
 11 2026 biennium and shall continue as adjusted on January 1, 2027, by the salary increment
 12 provided to state employees in the State/Executive Branch Budget.

16 **(1) Legislative Record:** Notwithstanding KRS 7.105, distribution of the final
 17 issue of the Legislative Record and the interim Legislative Record shall be suspended
 18 effective July 1, 2026.

19 **(2) Legislative Publications:** Notwithstanding KRS Chapters 27A and 57, the
 20 Acts of the General Assembly, the Journals of the Senate and House of Representatives,
 21 and the official Kentucky statute publications may be distributed by use of electronic
 22 versions only, at the discretion of the Director of the Legislative Research Commission.

23 **(3) Judicial Branch Salary Compensation Study:** Included in the above
 24 General Fund appropriation is \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 2026-2027 to support a contract
 25 with an external consultant to conduct a comprehensive salary and compensation study
 26 for the elected and nonelected personnel of the Judicial Branch. The study shall review
 27 current classifications, compensation levels, and market competitiveness and shall

1 include recommendations for potential adjustments to ensure equitable and competitive
 2 compensation practices. The consultant shall submit the results of the study to the Interim
 3 Joint Committee on Appropriations and Revenue by July 1, 2027.

9 **Unexpended Balance:** Notwithstanding KRS 45.229, any unexpended balance
 10 remaining at the close of fiscal year 2025-2026 shall not lapse but shall continue into
 11 fiscal year 2026-2027, and any unexpended balance in any succeeding fiscal year shall
 12 not lapse but shall continue into the following fiscal year.

18 **PART II**

19 **GENERAL PROVISIONS**

20 **1. Expenditure Authority:** The Director of the Legislative Research
 21 Commission, under the supervision of the Legislative Research Commission, may expend
 22 any of the funds appropriated for legislative operation and administration in any lawful
 23 manner and for any legal purpose consistent with the policies and practices of the
 24 Commission. No executive agency or statute governing the executive agencies of state
 25 government shall have the power to restrict or limit the actions of, or the expenditure of
 26 funds appropriated to, the Legislative Research Commission for the Legislative Branch of
 27 government.

1 **2. Capitol and Capitol Annex Capital Construction Expenditures:** Any
2 expenditure authorized by the Director of the Legislative Research Commission, under
3 the supervision of the Legislative Research Commission, relating to implementation of
4 KRS 56.463(4)(b), or relating to the Capitol Building, and funded by previous or current
5 appropriations to the Legislative Research Commission for the Legislative Branch of
6 government shall not be governed by KRS 7A.010, 7A.120, 45.750 to 45.810,
7 48.010(16), 48.020, and 48.110.

8 **3. Severability of Budget Provisions:** Appropriation items and sums in this Act
9 conform to KRS 48.311. If any section, any subsection, or any provision thereof shall be
10 invalid or unconstitutional, the decision of the courts shall not affect or impair any of the
11 remaining sections, subsections, or provisions.

12 **4. Duplicate Appropriation:** Any appropriation item and sum in this Act and in
13 an appropriation provision in another Act of the 2026 Regular Session of the General
14 Assembly which constitutes a duplicate appropriation shall be governed by KRS 48.312.

15 **5. Priority of Individual Appropriations:** KRS 48.313 shall control when a
16 total or subtotal figure in this Act conflicts with the sum of the appropriations of which it
17 consists.

18 **6. Appropriations Revisions:** Proposed revisions to Restricted Funds
19 appropriations in this Act shall be made and reported pursuant to KRS 48.630(10).

20 **7. Allowance in Lieu of Stationery:** Notwithstanding KRS 6.220, in lieu of
21 stationery, there shall be allowed to each member of the House of Representatives the
22 sum of \$350 and to each member of the Senate the sum of \$650. This allowance shall be
23 paid out of the State Treasury at the beginning of each legislative session.

24 **8. Salary Adjustments:** In each fiscal year, employees of the Legislative
25 Research Commission shall receive a salary adjustment in accordance with the salary
26 adjustment provided to state employees in the State/Executive Branch Budget.

27 **9. Administrative Expenses:** Pursuant to KRS 21.540, administrative expenses

1 shall be paid out of an administrative account which shall be funded by transfers of the
2 necessary moneys, in appropriate ratio, from the funds provided for in KRS 21.550 and
3 21.560.

4 **PART III**

5 **BUDGET REDUCTION OR SURPLUS EXPENDITURE PLAN**

6 The Legislative Branch shall participate in any Budget Reduction Plan or Surplus
7 Expenditure Plan in accordance with KRS Chapter 48, except that obligations essential to
8 the constitutional duties of the Legislative Branch shall be exempt from any Budget
9 Reduction Plan. The level of participation in a Budget Reduction Plan shall be at the
10 discretion of the Director and shall not exceed the actual percentage of revenue shortfall.
