(New Administrative Regulation)

201 KAR 20:471. Repeal of 201 KAR 20:470.

RELATES TO: KRS 314.137

STATUTORY AUTHORITY: KRS 314.131(1), 314.137

NECESSITY, FUNCTION, AND CONFORMITY: KRS 314.137 requires the board to promulgate administrative regulations to regulate dialysis technicians. This administrative regulation repeals 201 KAR 20:470 in conjunction with the promulgation of four new regulation covering the same subject matter as 201 KAR 20:470; namely, 201 KAR 20:472, 201 KAR 20:474, 201 KAR 20:476, and 201 KAR 20:478.

Section 1. 201 KAR 20:470, Dialysis technician credentialing requirements and training program standards, is hereby repealed.

PUBLIC HEARING AND COMMENT PERIOD: A public hearing on this administrative regulation shall be held on Monday, August 23, 2021 at 10:00 a.m. (EDT) in the office of the Kentucky Board of Nursing, 312 Whittington Parkway, Suite 300, Louisville, Kentucky. Individuals interested in being heard at this hearing shall notify this agency in writing five workdays prior to the hearing of their intent to attend. If no notification of intent to attend the hearing is received by that date, the hearing may be canceled. This hearing is open to the public. Any person who wishes to be heard will be given an opportunity to comment on the proposed administrative regulation. A transcript of the public hearing will not be made unless a written request for a transcript is made. If you do not wish to be heard at the public hearing, you may submit written comments on the proposed administrative regulation. Written comments shall be accepted until end of day (11:59 p.m., EDT) Tuesday, August 31, 2021. Send written notification of intent to be heard at the public hearing or written comments on the proposed administrative regulation to the contact person.
