

286.1-020 Duties of commissioner -- Administrative regulations.

- (1) The commissioner may promulgate, amend, and repeal any administrative regulations, forms, and orders as are necessary to interpret and carry out the provisions and intent of this chapter.
- (2) The commissioner and his or her designees shall be allowed their necessary traveling and other expenses of conducting their office.
- (3) The commissioner may designate the deputy commissioner, division directors, general counsel, or branch managers to sign documents under his or her instructions.
- (4) The department may accept any application or other document required to be filed with it in electronic format or in any other technology acceptable to the department.
