

304.1-110 "Certificate of authority" and "license" defined. (Effective July 15, 2026)

As used in this chapter, unless the context requires otherwise:

- (1) "Certificate of authority" means a certificate issued by the commissioner evidencing the authority of an insurer to transact insurance in this state; and
- (2) "License" means a license or other authorization granted by the commissioner pursuant to this chapter that authorizes the licensee to engage in a business or operation of insurance in this state other than as an insurer.
