

**217.188 Administrative regulations regarding poultry sold on farms, at farmers markets, and at roadside stands. (Effective July 15, 2026)**

- (1) For the purposes of this section, "end consumer" means a person who is the last person to purchase any food product and who does not resell the food product.
- (2) Notwithstanding any other provisions of law to the contrary, the secretary shall promulgate administrative regulations in accordance with KRS Chapter 13A to:
  - (a) Exclude slaughtering and processing of poultry on a farm for the purpose of conducting sales under 9 C.F.R. sec. 381.10 if the slaughtered and processed poultry or poultry products are sold to an end consumer on a farm, at a farmers market, or at a roadside stand;
  - (b) Require that poultry or poultry products processed under this section that are sold on a farm be refrigerated at the point of sale and labeled in compliance with the requirements of 9 C.F.R. sec. 381.10; and
  - (c) Require that poultry or poultry products processed under this section that are sold at a farmers market or at a roadside stand be frozen at the point of sale and labeled in compliance with the requirements of 9 C.F.R. sec. 381.10.
- (3) Notwithstanding any other provisions of law to the contrary, a local governmental agency shall not require any additional certification or inspection of poultry or poultry products of a farmer acting in compliance with the administrative regulations promulgated pursuant to this section.
