

**335.336 Licensure of applicant who holds active license from another state -- Exemptions. (Effective July 15, 2026)**

- (1) The board shall grant licensure under KRS 335.320 and 335.330 to an applicant who:
  - (a) Holds an active license from another state to practice as an independent marriage and family therapist;
  - (b) Is in good standing with the certifying or licensing board of that state;
  - (c) Is of good moral character;
  - (d) Has not had disciplinary actions of a serious nature brought against him or her by a registration, certification, or licensing board or agency;
  - (e) Has met the examination requirement in KRS 335.330(3); and
  - (f) Has paid the application fee to the board.
- (2) The applicant shall be exempt from:
  - (a) The education required in KRS 335.330(1); and
  - (b) The required hours of supervised experience in the practice of marriage and family therapy required in KRS 335.330(2).
