

29A.215 Recording and disclosure of certain information relating to grand jury proceedings prohibited. (Effective July 15, 2026)

- (1) Except as allowed under the Kentucky Rules of Criminal Procedure, a person present during any part of a grand jury proceeding shall not knowingly:
 - (a) Record any testimony or evidence presented during the proceeding; or
 - (b) Disclose or disseminate at any time, any evidence, testimony, or other information that the person witnessed, read, or heard while present at a grand jury proceeding.
- (2) This section shall not apply to a:
 - (a) Commonwealth's attorney or any person employed by a Commonwealth's attorney; or
 - (b) Peace officer;while engaged in the performance of his or her official duties.
