In response to Senator Meredith, Mr. Long stated the contract includes workers' compensation claim payments, not just administrative costs. Administrative fees are capped at \$1.45 million per fiscal year, and the state pays only for services provided based on a set fee schedule. Claim payments are handled separately by the cabinet.

In response to Senator Meredith, Ms. Shelton stated the third-party administrator (TPA) provides a monthly report of workers' compensation payments made, and the state reimburses the TPA for those costs.

In response to Senator Meredith, Mr. Long stated 5 companies submitted proposals. CCMSI received the highest evaluation score, were the second lowest in cost, finishing well ahead of the next highest bidder, and the claims administration program had received clean audit results.

A motion was made by Senator Meredith to disapprove the contract. Co-Chair Hart seconded the motion, which passed, with Senator Thomas and Representative Roarx voting no.

CHFS - OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY
Ingenesis, Inc., 2600000162; 22nd Century Technologies, Inc., 2600000163; Amergis Holdings, Inc., 2600000164; Tryfacta, Inc., 2600000165. Dr. Steven Stack, Secretary, CHFS, and Astrud Masterson, Executive Director, CHFS, discussed the contracts with the committee.

In response to Chair Douglas, Dr. Stack stated staffing companies are used to fill healthcare vacancies, which is a common industry practice. These contracts were awarded through a competitive procurement process under 45A, allowing both in-state and out-of-state companies to compete.

In response to Chair Douglas, Ms. Masterson stated the contracts were competitively bid by the Finance Cabinet in 2021 and will be rebid in 2028, at which time the agency will participate in developing the RFP.

A motion was made by Co-Chair Hart to consider the contracts as reviewed. Chair Douglas seconded the motion, which passed.

CHFS - OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY

Multi, 2600000248. Dr. Stack and Ms. Masterson discussed the contract with the committee.

In response to Senator Thomas, Dr. Stack stated a pre-approved pool of competitively selected vendors is used to quickly obtain specialized consulting services while complying with procurement laws. This streamlined process gives all approved vendors a chance to compete under established fee schedules, improving efficiency while balancing operational needs with legislative oversight.

A motion was made by Senator Meredith to disapprove the contract. The motion failed due to the lack of a second. A motion was made by Senator Thomas to consider the contract as reviewed. Representative Roarx seconded the motion, which passed with Senator Meredith and Co-Chair Hart voting no.

DEPARTMENT FOR MEDICAID SERVICES

Multi, 2600000260. Dr. Stack, Ms. Masterson, and Veronica Judy-Cecil, Senior Deputy Commissioner, DMS, CHFS, discussed the contract with the committee.

A motion was made by Senator Meredith to disapprove the contract. Co-Chair Hart seconded the motion which failed with Senator Richardson, Senator Thomas, Representative Roarx, and Representative McCool voting no. A motion was made by Senator Thomas to consider the contract as reviewed. Representative Roarx seconded the motion, which passed with Senator Meredith, Chair Douglas, and Co-Chair Hart voting no.

DEPARTMENT FOR MEDICAID SERVICES

Myers and Stauffer, LLC, 2600004129, 2600004129; Milliman, Inc., 2600004435. Dr. Stack, Ms. Judy-Cecil, and Lisa Lee, Commissioner, DMS, CHFS, discussed the contracts with the committee.

In response to Senator Meredith, Ms. Lee stated the 2 contracts serve different purposes. Milliman sets managed care capitation rates and supports medical loss ratio analysis and Myers and Stauffer set reimbursement rates and reviews cost reports for fee-for-service providers such as hospitals and federally qualified health centers.

In response to Senator Meredith, Dr. Stack stated for cost-based providers, reimbursement is based on verified actual costs rather than fixed rates. The contractor reviews and validates cost reports, verifies supporting documentation, and calculates the reimbursement amounts owed.

In response to Senator Meredith, Ms. Lee stated Milliman analyzes managed care data to set capitation payment rates for managed care organizations (MCOs), not reimbursement rates for individual providers.

In response to Senator Meredith, Ms. Judy-Cecil stated Milliman is an actuarial firm required by federal law to certify managed care capitation rates, while Myers and Stauffer is an accounting firm who develops cost-based reimbursement rates for fee-for-service providers.

In response to Senator Meredith, Dr. Stack stated rate studies help determine market rates, meet legislative and federal requirements, and provide data to inform policy decisions. Even if reimbursement does not immediately match market rates, the findings can support future funding increases and legislative action.

In response to Senator Meredith, Ms. Lee stated Myers and Stauffer focus on cost-based reimbursement, calculating rates for providers such as hospitals and federally qualified health centers based on actual costs and Medicare methodologies. They also calculate annual Medicare-related payment increases, but do not set physician or other fee schedules.

In response to Senator Meredith, Ms. Judy-Cecil stated cost-based provider rates are determined using federally required reviews of actual costs, while other fee schedules are based on Medicare or market comparisons. Contractors provide analysis and forecasting, but the Medicaid agency, not the contractors, decide whether to change reimbursement rates based on provider access needs and funding availability.

In response to Chair Douglas, Ms. Judy-Cecil stated the contract is billed on an hourly basis, with rates varying based on the staff member's role, qualifications, and level of expertise.

A motion was made by Senator Meredith to consider the contracts as reviewed. Representative Roarx seconded the motion, which passed

DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION

Curriculum Associates, LLC, 2600003292. Karen Wirth, Director of Budgets and Financial Management, KDE, and Jennifer Stafford, Associate Commissioner, Office of Assessment and Accountability, KDE, discussed the contract with the committee.

In response to Chair Douglas, Ms. Stafford stated kindergarten is intended to provide the foundational skills students need for success throughout elementary, middle, and high school, as well as lifelong learning. While children are expected to begin developing these skills at home, all incoming kindergarten students complete a standardized screening to assess their readiness for school.

In response to Representative Roarx, Ms. Stafford stated kindergarten screening results are shared with preschool programs, parents, and educators to help understand how prepared children are for kindergarten and identify needed support. The assessment measures academic, developmental, physical, social-emotional, and independence skills, such as language, recognizing letters and shapes, motor skills, and self-help abilities.

A motion was made by Chair Douglas to disapprove the contract. Senator Meredith seconded the motion, which failed with Senator Thomas, Representative McCool, Representative Roarx, and Co-Chair Hart voting no. A motion was made by

Representative Roarx to consider the contract as reviewed. Senator Thomas seconded the motion, which passed with Senator Meredith and Chair Douglas voting no.

KENTUCKY COMMUNICATIONS NETWORK AUTHORITY

Ice Miller, LLP, 2600002675. Adam Adkins, General Counsel, KCNA; Jim Barnhart, Chief Information Officer, COT, Executive Director, KCNA; and Jason Johnson, Deputy Executive Director, KCNA, discussed the contract with the committee.

In response to Chair Douglas, Mr. Johnson stated Modification 108 was needed to increase the prior fiscal year contract amount to pay outstanding invoices for services already provided before the contract ended June 30, 2026. The new biennium contract returns to the previous funding level of about \$1.8 million. The modification was required for proper accounting and to ensure expenses were paid under the contract year in which the services were performed.

A motion was made by Senator Meredith to disapprove the contract. Co-Chair Hart seconded the motion, which failed, with Senators Richardson, Thomas and Representatives McCool and Roarx voting no. A motion was made by Senator Thomas to consider the contract as reviewed. Representative Roarx seconded the motion, which passed with Chair Douglas, Co-Chair Hart, and Senator Meredith voting no.

NORTHERN KENTUCKY UNIVERSITY

Risepoint, LLC, 2027-107. Christopher Calvert, Chief Financial Officer, NKU, and Jenny Sand, Executive Director of Government and Community Relations, NKU, discussed the contract with the committee.

In response to Chair Douglas, Mr. Calvert stated Rise Point supports recruitment and digital marketing for specific online programs. NKU pays a percentage of net tuition revenue only when a student enrolls. Students with waived tuition do not generate payments. The current revenue share rate is 47% of net tuition, reduced from the original 50% rate when the program began.

A motion was made by Senator Richardson to consider the contract as reviewed. Co-Chair Hart seconded the motion, which passed.

Stantec Consulting Services, Inc., 1800002069. Eric Pelfrey, Director for Professional Services, Department of Highways, KYTC, and Natalie House-Lewis, Project Manager, Engineer, KYTC, discussed the contract with the committee.

A motion was made by Co-Chair Hart to consider the contract as reviewed. Chair Douglas seconded the motion, which passed.

FACILITIES & SUPPORT SERVICES

Lord Aeck & Sargent Planning & Design, Inc., 2500002393. Scott Baker, Executive Director, Office of Facility Development and Efficiency, Finance and Administration Cabinet, discussed the contract with the committee.

A motion was made by Chair Douglas to consider the contract as reviewed. Senator Meredith seconded the motion, which passed.

KENTUCKY COMMUNICATIONS NETWORK AUTHORITY

Ice Miller, LLP, 2400001798. Mr. Adkins, Mr. Barnhart, and Mr. Johnson, discussed the contract with the committee.

In response to Chair Douglas, Mr. Adkins stated the legal services contract began in 2018 at \$375 per hour. After negotiations, the rate was increased to \$475 per hour, which is below what a standard 5% annual increase would have resulted in and remains on the low end of national rates for firms of this size. The firm provides specialized legal services, including bond counsel, contract counsel, and broadband expertise.

A motion was made by Senator Meredith to disapprove the contract. Co-Chair Hart seconded the motion, which passed with Senator Thomas and Representative Roarx voting no.

KENTUCKY STATE FAIR BOARD

Dsbeck, LLC, 2600003284.

A motion was made by Co-Chair Hart to defer the contract to the August 2026 meeting. Senator Meredith seconded the motion, which passed with Senator Thomas and Representative Roarx voting no.

KY PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

Engleman Fallon, PLLC, 2500000215. Linda Bridwell, Executive Director, KPSC, and Ron Parritt, Deputy Executive Director, KPSC, discussed the contract with the committee.

In response to Co-Chair Hart, Ms. Bridwell stated the contract provides specialized legal services related to a complaint before the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) over how Kentucky Power's parent company allocates transmission costs. The state believes the tariff process may be costing Kentucky Power customers up to \$15 million more than necessary. The legal work began in 2024 and continues through appeals after the complaint and rehearing requests were denied.

A motion was made by Senator Meredith to consider the contract as reviewed. Co-Chair Hart seconded the motion, which passed.

THE FOLLOWING MEMORANDA OF AGREEMENTS WERE SELECTED FOR FURTHER REVIEW:

COUNCIL ON POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION

Kentucky Department of Education, 2600004226. Leslie Brown, Assistant Vice President of Operations, CPE, discussed the contract with the committee.

In response to Representative McCool, Ms. Brown stated CPE has 115 employees, with only 4 positions filled through contracts with outside agencies. These partnerships help support shared goals, such as the K–12 to postsecondary education pipeline and workforce development. The contracts do not include additional fees, though CPE may be responsible for its share of retirement payouts under state policy. Contract salary adjustments are generally aligned with CPE employee pay increases, and this particular contract was reduced from the prior year because additional duties had ended.

A motion was made by Chair Douglas to consider the contract as reviewed. Senator Meredith seconded the motion, which passed.

DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION

Kentucky Science and Technology Corporation, 2600002470; Kentucky Science and Technology Corporation, 2600002547. Ms. Wirth and Micki Marinelli, Chief Academic Officer, KDE, discussed the contracts with the committee.

In response to Chair Douglas, Ms. Marinelli stated the contracts expand access to college readiness programs by supporting teachers and students. Advance Kentucky receives \$1.9 million annually to provide AP course training for teachers and student support groups aimed at increasing AP exam success, serving 37 districts and 40 high schools. Advanced Kentucky also supports middle school algebra access by helping grades 6–8 teachers prepare students to take Algebra I for high school credit, serving 31 districts and 46 schools.

A motion was made by Senator Meredith to consider the contracts as reviewed. Senator Thomas seconded the motion, which passed.

DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION

Teach for America, Inc., 2600002595. Ms. Wirth and Veda Stewart, Director of Educator Recruitment and Development, KDE, discussed the contract with the committee.

In response to Representative McCool, Ms. Stewart stated the program focuses on recruiting and retaining teachers in high-need areas, particularly in Central Appalachia, eastern Kentucky, and rural communities. It targets hard-to-fill subjects such as STEM, math, physics, and foreign languages, initially supporting teachers for 2 years with the goal of long-term retention. In the 2024–2025 reporting period, 35 teachers were recruited and 22 were retained. Since 2019, 24 Teach for America pathway participants have earned professional teaching certificates in Kentucky.

A motion was made by Senator Thomas to consider the contract as reviewed. Representative Roarx seconded the motion, which passed.

EXEMPTION REQUESTS:

KENTUCKY DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE

Kentucky Department of Agriculture requested an exemption from Committee Policy Statement #99-4, which prohibits contracts and agreements from extending beyond the biennium to amend the effective term of its Chronic Wasting Disease durability grant agreement to be co-extensive with the federal grant term. A motion was made by Senator Meredith to grant the request to September 30, 2026. Chair Douglas seconded the motion, which passed without objection.

KENTUCKY STATE POLICE

Kentucky State Police requested an exemption from Committee Policy Statement #99-4, which prohibits contracts and agreements from extending beyond the biennium for the purpose of executing 4 subawards for the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration's Motor Carrier Safety Assistance Program. A motion was made by Senator Meredith to grant the request to September 30, 2028. Chair Douglas seconded the motion, which passed without objection.
