- "→SECTION 7. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 438 IS CREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:
- (1) The provisions of Sections 1 to 6 of this Act shall become operational upon the effective date of this Act.
- (2) Notwithstanding any provision of Sections 1 to 6 of this Act to the contrary, on a biennial basis, a local government, as defined by Section 1 of this Act, shall have the authority to pass, by at least a majority of the total elected officials of the local government's legislative body, a measure to opt out of the requirements of Sections 1 to 6 of this Act for a period of two (2) years.
- (3) A local government that opts out of the smoking ban pursuant to subsection (2) of this section shall have the authority to continue to opt out of the requirements of Sections 1 to 6 of this Act every two (2) years, provided that the measure to opt out of the requirements of Sections 1 to 6 of this Act passes by at least a majority of the total elected officials of the local government's legislative body. If at any time a local government fails to opt out of the smoking ban via the process established pursuant to this section, then it shall be prohibited from opting out of the smoking ban in the future, and the
