SUMMARY OF LEGISLATION: Amend KRS 403.720 to include stalking and conduct which seriously alarms another person as grounds for the issuance of a domestic violence protective order; amend KRS 525.080 to include electronic communications within the definition of harassing communications.

STATE IMPACT : Class A, B & C felonies are based on an average daily prison rate of \$60.38. Most Class D felons are housed in one of 78 full service jails for up to 5 years. DOC's cost to incarcerate a felony inmate in a jail is \$32.92 per day (includes jail per diem, medical & central office costs), not including substance abuse treatment. Projections are based on the daily rate x 365 x number of years.

Creates no new felonies.
LOCAL IMPACT : Local governments are responsible for the cost of incarcerating individuals charged with Class A or Emisdemeanors and felony defendants until disposition of the case. While the expense varies by jail, this estimated impact will be based on \$32.25 per day, which equals the per diem and medical that DOC pays jails to house felony offenders.
Potential Impact: Section 2 Would amend KRS 525.080 to include electronic communications within the definition of harassing communications. Harassing Communications is a Class B misdemeanor; by expanding the definition to include electronic communications has the potential to increase Class B misdemeanor convictions for Harassing Communications.
Based on the \$32.25 per diem rate, the local impact is estimated as follows:
A Class B misdemeanor is up to 90 days in jail. 10 Class B misdemeanants: up to \$28,703.
1 Class B misdemeanant: up to \$2,870. 100 Class B misdemeanants: up to \$287,025.
