MEASURE'S PURPOSE: The purpose of this measure is to allow small farm wineries to produce up to 1,000 gallons of brandy per year to fortify their wine products.

PROVISIONS/MECHANICS: This motion amends KRS 243.155 to allow small farm wineries to produce up to 1,000 gallons of brandy annually. The brandy must be made from 100% Kentucky grapes, fruit, wine, or pomace and does not count towards the 50,000 gallon wine production limit. The produced brandy can be used only to fortify wine products, but may not be sold as a stand-alone product. Fortified wine products may be sold by the small farm winery or may be given to patrons (up to two complimentary ounces per day).

FISCAL EXPLANATION: The fiscal impact from this bill is entirely from the new employees it would require to regulate and monitor the small farm wineries new distilling operations. Since the small farm wineries would not be required to pay for a Class B distilling license (cost of \$1,000) but would still need to be monitored, the cost of enforcement would not be offset by new revenues. The amount of employees needed to monitor the small farm wineries is indeterminable since it is unknown how many would start producing brandy. However, the costs would be minimal.
