AN ACT relating to e-cigarettes.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 211 IS CREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) The Department for Public Health shall establish, promote, and maintain a statewide e-cigarette education and awareness program using available federal funds, state funds appropriated for that purpose, and other available funding. The program shall:
 - (a) Promote the public awareness of the harmful effects of e-cigarette usage; and
 - (b) Promote health-care provider awareness of the harmful effects of ecigarette usage.
- (2) The education component of the program created in subsection (1) of this section shall educate and inform parents, adolescents, health-care providers, school personnel, child-care providers, and the general public about the harmful effects of e-cigarette usage and shall include but not be limited to:
 - (a) Information about how nicotine is highly addictive and toxic;
 - (b) Information about how e-cigarettes are especially harmful to adolescents and pregnant women;
 - (c) Information about the increases in e-cigarette related poisonings;
 - (d) Information about how e-cigarettes are toxic to users and to others through secondhand emissions;
 - (e) Information about misleading advertising and labeling; and
 - (f) Information for users about how to quit.
- (3) The department may consult, contract, or establish a cooperative relationship with local health departments, libraries, and community organizations to carry out the requirements of subsections (1) and (2) of this section.

(4) The department may use existing publications, the Department for Public Health Web site, and the Kentucky e-Health Network to promote health-care provider awareness of the harmful effects of e-cigarette usage.
