

human trafficking victims in Kentucky was estimated in 2014 to be fewer than one thousand. It is indeterminable how many of these victims are minors. It would be expected that there are fewer perpetrators in Kentucky than victims.

Given these relatively few numbers, and the fact that human trafficking, prostitution and other commercial sexual activity is already illegal, it is expected that the fiscal impact of HB 515 GA on local law enforcement, prosecutors, or jailers, would be minimal.
