

A JOINT RESOLUTION designating a bridge on Kentucky Route 699 in honor and memory of fallen WWI soldier and Leslie County native Frank Baker.

WHEREAS, Frank Baker was born on March 17, 1892 to Eli Baker and Nancy Williams Baker, one of ten children; and

WHEREAS, Frank Baker was married to Laura Baker; and

WHEREAS, Frank Baker was a member of the United States Army, a private with the 166 Infantry Regiment, 83rd Division during World War I; and

WHEREAS, on July 28, 1918, Pvt. Frank Baker departed these earthly bounds, killed in action in the midst of World War I; and

WHEREAS, the General Assembly sees fit to honor the bravery and sacrifice of Pvt. Frank Baker by designating a bridge in his honor and memory;

NOW, THEREFORE,

Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

➔Section 1. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate the bridge on Kentucky Route 699 in Leslie County, north of Coon Creek Road, as the "Pvt. Frank Baker Memorial Bridge," and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution, erect the appropriate signage.
