

A JOINT RESOLUTION directing the Transportation Cabinet to erect signs on United States Route 25E in Knox County that proclaim Knox County as the home of the United States Trampoline and Tumbling Association 2014 National Trampoline Champion, Emmaleigh Bargo.

WHEREAS, Emmaleigh Bargo was born on February 11, 2004, to Michael and Pamela Bargo and has one brother, Brandon Bargo; and

WHEREAS, Emmaleigh Bargo attends fifth grade at Barbourville City School; and

WHEREAS, Emmaleigh Bargo is a gymnast and All-Star cheerleader at Triple Crown Elite gym in Barbourville; and

WHEREAS, Emmaleigh Bargo has been a competitive gymnast for one year; and

WHEREAS, Emmaleigh Bargo has been an All-Star cheerleader for three years; and

WHEREAS, Emmaleigh Bargo's squad has won multiple championships and participated at the national level in Disney World; and

WHEREAS, Emmaleigh Bargo has competed in the categories of trampoline, floor, and double mini-trampoline in various gymnastic competitions in Kentucky, and has received numerous awards; and

WHEREAS, Emmaleigh Bargo was named the 2014 U.S.T.A. National Trampoline Champion in June 2014;

NOW, THEREFORE,

Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

➔Section 1. The Transportation Cabinet is hereby directed to honor Emmaleigh Bargo by erecting signs on United States Highway 25E at the Knox County/Laurel County line and at the Knox County/Bell County line that read, "Home of the 2014 U.S.T.A. National Trampoline Champion, Emmaleigh Bargo." The signs erected under this section shall remain in place at least one year from the date of their placement.
