

A RESOLUTION honoring the Murray State University men's basketball team upon winning the 2014-2015 Ohio Valley Conference regular season championship.

WHEREAS, on February 21, 2015, the Murray State University Racers defeated the Austin Peay Governors 89-54 to clinch the regular season Ohio Valley Conference championship; and

WHEREAS, the win was Murray State's 24th of the year against only four losses, and continued a winning streak that began in November 2014 and currently sits at 22 games; and

WHEREAS, with one more win, Murray State will tie the school and Ohio Valley Conference record of 23 wins set by the 2011-2012 Murray State team; and

WHEREAS, the Racers have been led this season by sophomore Cameron Payne, who averages 19.7 points per game, and senior Jarvis Williams, who averages 15 points and 8 rebounds; and

WHEREAS, the season is a return to form for Murray State, which won 23 games in 2013-2014 and has seen a consistent level of winning under Coach Steve Prohm, who notched his 99th career win against Austin Peay; and

WHEREAS, this Honorable Body hereby congratulates the Murray State University Racers upon winning the 2014-2015 Ohio Valley Conference regular season championship, acknowledges the hard work of Head Coach Steve Prohm and his staff, and grants the team best wishes as it continues its historic run toward another NCAA Tournament berth;
