

A RESOLUTION adjourning the House of Representatives in honor of Lisa M. Rudzinski upon being named Director of the Ranger Division for the Kentucky State Parks.

WHEREAS, Lisa Rudzinski is a daughter of this Commonwealth, having been born in Bowling Green and educated at the University of Kentucky; and

WHEREAS, Lisa Rudzinski proudly served for 21 years with the Kentucky State Police. Beginning her exemplary career as a trooper, she was promoted to Post Commander and served in London, Bowling Green, and Richmond. She also served as Deputy Director for the State Police Administrative Division; and

WHEREAS, in January 2015, Lisa Rudzinski was named Director of the Ranger Division of the Kentucky State Parks, becoming the first woman to head the state park rangers and among the first women to to lead a statewide law enforcement division; and

WHEREAS, there is no symbol of the natural beauty of this Commonwealth greater than our state parks, and the safety and services that Kentucky's state park rangers offer on a daily basis is invaluable to the culture, economic vitality, and tradition on which all Kentuckians pride themselves; and

WHEREAS, Lisa Rudzinski, in her new and well-deserved role, has vowed to help protect our state parks, and the House of Representatives hereby congratulates her upon this momentous occasion and wishes her the best of luck as she continues to work on behalf of the common good;

NOW, THEREFORE,

Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
