WHEREAS, Jay Roberts was a former environmental inspector for the Kentucky Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Waste Management and had been an inspector for the Division of Surface Mining in Prestonsburg; and

WHEREAS, Jay Roberts was an avid outdoorsman and amateur geologist; and

WHEREAS, Jay Roberts departed this earthly life on January 10, 2015, leaving his family, friends, and an entire community in solemn mourning; and

WHEREAS, Jay Roberts was preceded in death by his parents and his brother, Norman Lee Roberts.
