

(at least every five years by state law) revise their ordinances to eliminate "redundant, obsolete, inconsistent, and invalid provisions." The cost of this mandate would be less if the repeal or revision were done in conjunction with this periodic updating of ordinances or if part of any fine might be applied to the costs to administer or monitor.
