

A RESOLUTION respectfully urging United States Senate Majority Leader Mitch McConnell and all members of the United States Senate to confirm Loretta Elizabeth Lynch as the 83rd United States Attorney General.

WHEREAS, the office of the United States Attorney General is crucial to the administration of equal justice and the protection of civil rights throughout the country; and

WHEREAS, Loretta Elizabeth Lynch has a proven track record of successfully prosecuting violent crime and corruption as a United States District Attorney; and

WHEREAS, President Barack Obama nominated Loretta Elizabeth Lynch for the position of United States Attorney General on November 8, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the United States Senate judiciary committee voted to confirm Loretta Elizabeth Lynch on February 26, 2015 with bipartisan support; and

WHEREAS, Loretta Elizabeth Lynch has been subjected to the longest delay of confirmation as a nominee for the office of United States Attorney General in thirty years;
