

A RESOLUTION adjourning the Senate in honor and loving memory of Suk Man Rai and Chita Chuwan.

WHEREAS, Suk Man Rai, a student at Fern Creek High School, and Chita Chuwan, a student at Seneca High School, were killed when a train struck their vehicle on Bardstown Road in Louisville on March 14, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Suk Man Rai, 19, and Chita Chuwan, 16, were both Nepali-Bhutanese refugees who had immigrated to the United States with their families in search of a better life; and

WHEREAS, Suk Man Rai was on pace to graduate from Fern Creek and would have been the first in his family to graduate from high school in the United States; and

WHEREAS, the members of this Honorable Body pray for the families of Suk Man Rai and Chita Chuwan, and express sorrow for the Fern Creek and Seneca High School communities as they grieve the loss of these special young people;

NOW, THEREFORE,

Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

➔Section 1. The Senate hereby expresses its deepest and most profound condolences upon the passing of Suk Man Rai and Chita Chuwan, and extends its heartfelt sympathy to their family, friends, and community in this time of loss.

➔Section 2. When the Senate adjourns this day, it does so in honor and loving memory of Suk Man Rai and Chita Chuwan.

➔Section 3. The Clerk of the Senate is directed to transmit two copies of this Resolution to Senator Morgan McGarvey for delivery.
