WHEREAS, Tim Bostic was the editor and publisher of the Salyersville *Independent* for 35 years, the editor of the Williamson *Daily News*, and the sports editor of the Big Sandy *News*; and

WHEREAS, Tim Bostic was active in his community, serving two terms as the Salyersville Mayor. He also served as Assistant to the Pike County Judge/Executive and was a member of the Pike County Board of Education and the WYMT Mountain Classic Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, Tim Bostic was the coach of Magoffin County High School baseball and softball for over sixteen years, a position that he held dear. Much beloved by his players and the members of his community, Coach Bostic touched the lives of all those who were lucky enough to play for him; and

WHEREAS, Tim Bostic departed this earthly life on December 28, 2014, leaving his family, friends, and an entire community in solemn mourning; and

WHEREAS, Tim Bostic is survived by his beloved wife, Carol Ann Bostic; seven daughters; two sons; eight grandchildren; three great-grandchildren; and three sisters;
