Coach Hines, who took over the Pulaski program in 1999, has won an extraordinary 50 games since the 2010 season; and

WHEREAS, this honorable body congratulates the Pulaski County High School Maroons on their first-ever state championship, commends the hard work of Head Coach John Hines and his staff for their exemplary work, and acknowledges the support of all the fans in Pulaski County who have helped make this team a success;
