- "→SECTION 1. IT IS PROPOSED THAT A NEW SECTION 99A BE ADDED TO THE CONSTITUTION OF KENTUCKY TO READ AS FOLLOWS:
- (1) If the legislative body of a county adopts an ordinance abolishing the office of Constable, then, upon the next expiration of the term set forth in Section 99 of this Constitution, the office shall cease to exist in that county. If the legislative body of that county subsequently adopts an ordinance reestablishing the office, then the election and service of Constable shall resume in that county, beginning with the next election scheduled under Section 99 of this Constitution.
- (2) If a county does not adopt an ordinance to abolish the office of Constable, a city within that county may pass an ordinance to eliminate the powers of the office of Constable within the city limits of that city. Upon the next expiration of the term set forth in Section 99 of this Constitution, the powers of that office shall cease to exist in that city. If the legislative body of that city subsequently adopts an ordinance reestablishing the powers of the office of Constable, then the powers and services of the office of Constable shall resume in that city, beginning with the next election scheduled under Section 99 of this Constitution."; and
