AN ACT relating to assisted-living communities.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS 194A.700 TO 194A.729 IS CREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

By September 1 of each year, and in accordance with the latest recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, each assisted-living community certified pursuant to this chapter shall provide residents with educational information or educational opportunities on influenza disease. The educational information or educational opportunities shall include but not be limited to the following:

- (1) The risks associated with influenza disease;
- (2) The availability, effectiveness, and known contraindications of the influenza immunization;
- (3) The causes and symptoms of influenza; and
- (4) The means by which influenza is spread.

Nothing in this section shall require any assisted-living community to provide or pay for any vaccination against influenza.
