"➔SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 65 IS CREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

(1) A local law enforcement model policy committee composed of at least one (1) representative of the Department of Criminal Justice Training, the Kentucky League of Cities, the Kentucky Association of Counties, the Kentucky Association of Chiefs of Police, and the Kentucky Sheriff's Association shall design, develop, and update, as needed, a model policy or policies regarding the use of eyewitness identification procedures and techniques for the use of local law enforcement agencies charged with enforcing criminal law in Kentucky.

(2) Each of the organizations represented on the committee created pursuant to subsection (1) of this section shall make available the model policy or policies on eyewitness identification procedures and techniques and any subsequent updated revisions to all local law enforcement agencies, including sheriff's departments and city and county police departments.

(3) All local law enforcement agencies, including sheriff departments and city and county

*police departments, are strongly urged to adopt and implement written eyewitness identification policies and procedures of their own based on the model policy or policies developed under subsection (1) of this section by December 31, 2016.*

- (4) Upon adoption, a copy of the eyewitness policy or policies shall be filed with the Kentucky Department of Local Government within thirty (30) days of adoption. Any subsequent revision to the policies filed pursuant to this section shall be filed with the department within ninety (90) days of adoption. Eyewitness identification policies adopted pursuant to this section and any subsequent revisions shall be subject to disclosure pursuant to KRS 61.870 to 61.884."*
