On page 1, lines 20 through 27, and on page 2, lines 1 and 2, delete the language in its entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

"In the year two thousand, and every six years thereafter, there shall be an election in each county for a Circuit Court Clerk~~], and for a Commonwealth's Attorney, in each circuit court district, unless that office be abolished~~], who shall hold his or her office~~[their respective offices]~~ for six years from the first Monday in January after his or her~~[their]~~ election, and until the election and qualification of his or her successor~~[their successors]~~. *In the year two thousand and eighteen, there shall be an election for a Commonwealth's Attorney in each circuit court district, unless that office be abolished, who shall hold his or her office for four years from the first Monday in January after his or her election, and until the election and qualification of his or her successor, and in the year two thousand and twenty-two, and every eight years thereafter, there shall be an election for a Commonwealth's Attorney in each circuit court district, unless that office be abolished, who shall hold his or her office for eight years from the first Monday in January after his or her election, and until the election and qualification of his or her successor.*"

On page 4, lines 7 through 12, after the colon on line 7, delete the noncodified language in its entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following: " "Are you in favor of requiring the Supreme
