AN ACT relating to the use of drone for an unlawful purpose.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 525 IS CREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) As used in this section, "drone" means any unmanned aircraft:
 - (a) For which registration with the Federal Aviation Administration is required pursuant to 14 C.F.R. secs. 48.1 et seq; and
 - (b) That is labeled or should be labeled with an N-number or other unique identifying number issued by the Federal Aviation Administration pursuant to the requirements of 14 C.F.R. sec. 48.205.
- (2) A person is guilty of unlawful use of a drone when he or she uses a drone:
 - (a) To engage in harassing conduct prohibited by KRS 525.070;
 - (b) To commit an act of voyeurism prohibited by KRS 531.090;
 - (c) To commit an act of video voyeurism prohibited by KRS 531.100;
 - (d) In the commission of an act of burglary or trespass prohibited by KRS Chapter 511; or
 - (e) In the commission of an act of theft by unlawful taking or disposition prohibited by KRS 514.030.
- (3) This section is intended to be a separate offense and shall be punished in addition to the underlying offense occurring during the same course of conduct.
- (4) (a) Unlawful use of a drone as prohibited by subsection (2)(a) of this section is a violation.
 - (b) Unlawful use of a drone as prohibited by subsection (2)(b) to (e) of this section is a Class A misdemeanor.
- (5) This section shall not apply to the use of a drone:
 - (a) By a law enforcement officer during a lawful criminal investigation; or
 - (b) For any lawful commercial or personal use.
