

AN ACT relating to county clerks.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

➔Section 1. 1860 Kentucky Acts Chapter 351, approved February 18, 1860, entitled "AN ACT to establish an office for the recording of deeds and mortgages at Covington." is repealed in its entirety.

➔Section 2. The repeal of the Kentucky Acts Chapter in Section 1 of this Act shall not be construed to invalidate any filing on the basis of its filing being done in a branch clerk's office located in a place other than the county seat of the county or within a clerk's office within the county seat, nor shall it be construed to remove the authority of county clerks authorized to operate branch offices as permitted under KRS 67.035.
