

AN ACT relating to idling motor vehicles.

***Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

➔Section 1. KRS 189.430 is amended to read as follows:

- (1) The driver of a motor vehicle when traveling upon a down grade shall not coast with the gears of the vehicle in neutral.
- (2) The driver of a commercial motor vehicle when traveling upon a down grade shall not coast with the clutch disengaged.
- (3) ~~A~~No person operating or in charge of a motor vehicle shall ***not*** permit it to stand unattended ***while the engine idles, unless all doors to the vehicle are locked. A person shall not leave a vehicle idling under this subsection for more than fifteen (15) minutes.***
- ~~(4) A person operating or in charge of a motor vehicle shall not~~[without first stopping the engine, locking the ignition and removing the key, nor] allow it to stand upon any perceptible grade without effectively setting the brake and turning the front wheels to the curb or side of the highway.
