**Actuarial Impact – House Bill 470 – 16 RS BR 2002**

Dear Beau:

As requested, we have prepared an actuarial analysis of the impact of House Bill 470 – 16 RS BR 2002 on the Kentucky Teachers' Retirement System. Most of the provisions of the legislation appear to be only in the nature of technical corrections and would have a negligible impact on the Retirement System. However, changes to provisions in KRS 161.612 and 161.661 relating to disability retirement would require minor changes to eligibility and benefits and would produce a slight savings to the System over time.
