AN ACT relating to charitable organizations and accountability.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

- →SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 367 IS CREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:
- (1) The Attorney General shall provide public access to records relating to financial accountability of charitable organizations through the display of the records on a Web site. The Web site shall provide a list of names of charitable organizations that:
 - (a) Are engaged in or planning to engage in solicitation for a charitable campaign in the state of Kentucky;
 - (b) Are required by KRS 367.657 to file a copy of federal Form 990 or notice of intent to solicit with the Office of the Attorney General; and
 - (c) Have failed to meet the financial accountability standards recommended by

 the American Institute of Philanthropy's CharityWatch, which recommends

 that charitable organizations dedicate at least seventy-five percent (75%) of
 their budgets to the organizations' stated charitable goals or programs.
 - Inclusion on this list shall be based on a three (3) year average of annual expenditures.
- (2) Information on the Web site shall be updated on an annual basis and include:
 - (a) The fifty (50) charitable organizations that fell farthest from the American

 Institute of Philanthropy's Charitywatch charitable spending

 recommendation;
 - (b) Each organization's average annual expenditures;
 - (c) The actual percentage spent on the organization's stated charitable purpose; and
 - (d) A link to the American Institute of Philanthropy's Charitywatch Web site.
- (3) The Attorney General shall promulgate administrative regulations necessary to

effectuate the disclosures required by this section.
