

A JOINT RESOLUTION designating the Sgt. Dennie Neace Memorial Highway.

WHEREAS, Sgt. Dennie Neace was born August 3, 1947, in Bonnyman, Kentucky, the loving son of Granville Neace and Jeanette Deaton Neace; and

WHEREAS, Sgt. Dennie Neace served in the United States Army in the 1st Cavalry Division, 1st Battalion, 12th Cavalry, C Company; and

WHEREAS, on May 31, 1967, Sgt. Dennie Neace was killed in action in Quang Tin Province, South Vietnam, by small arms gunfire; and

WHEREAS, for his service, Sgt. Dennie Neace was awarded the National Defense Service Medal, the Combat Infantryman Badge, the Vietnam Campaign Medal, the Vietnam Service Medal, and the Purple Heart; and

WHEREAS, Sgt. Dennie Neace valiantly served his country; and

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Kentucky is deeply grateful for the sacrifices and services of Sgt. Dennie Neace; and

WHEREAS, the passing of Sgt. Dennie Neace left a void that cannot be filled and he is mourned across the length and breadth of the Commonwealth;

NOW, THEREFORE,

Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

➔Section 1. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate Kentucky Route 267 in Perry County, from Kentucky Highway 15 to the town of Typo, as the "Sgt. Dennie Neace Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution erect appropriate signs denoting this designation.
