

A JOINT RESOLUTION directing the Transportation Cabinet to erect signs on Kentucky Route 192 Bypass in Laurel County that proudly proclaim Laurel County as the "Home of the 2005 to 2015 Bluegrass 10,000 Crank Wheelchair Champion Greg Queen."

WHEREAS, after years of riding and racing bikes, Greg Queen suffered a paralyzing injury; and

WHEREAS, Greg Queen began competing in the Bluegrass 10,000 as a wheelchair participant; and

WHEREAS, Greg Queen won two push wheelchair titles in the 1990s; and

WHEREAS, Greg Queen has won 11 consecutive titles in the crank wheelchair division; and

WHEREAS, Greg Queen set a course record for Men's Crank Wheelchair in the 2014 Bluegrass 10,000 with a time of 18:45;

NOW, THEREFORE,

***Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

➔Section 1. The Transportation Cabinet is hereby directed to honor Greg Queen by erecting signs on Kentucky 192 Bypass in Laurel County that read, "Home of the 2005 to 2015 Bluegrass 10,000 Crank Wheelchair Champion Greg Queen." The signs erected under this section shall remain in place for at least one year from the date of their placement.
