

A JOINT RESOLUTION designating a portion of United States Route 127 in Anderson County as the "Logann Driskell Memorial Highway."

WHEREAS, Logann Driskell was born January 26, 1984, and passed away December 13, 2014, from injuries sustained in an auto accident; and

WHEREAS, Logann Driskell was survived by his loving parents, Steve and Merry Corn Driskell; his beloved wife, Mindy Drummond Driskell; two beloved children, Brianna Michelle Watson and Bentley Shane Driskell; his paternal grandmother, Edna Mae Searcy Driskell; and father-in-law David Drummond and mother-in-law Tammy Slayton; and

WHEREAS, upon graduating from Anderson County High School in 2002, Logann Driskell began working for the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet as a Highway Equipment Operator I, where he worked himself up through the ranks and was promoted to Highway Superintendent I in February 2014; and

WHEREAS, Logann Driskell was a dedicated employee for more than 11 years, and was respected very much by his co-workers; and

WHEREAS, Logann Driskell's reputation was that he was a leader, a go-getter, and could be depended on to get things accomplished; and

WHEREAS, Logann Driskell was a member of the Ballard Baptist Church, attended Ninevah Christian Church, and enjoyed his family and collecting Ford tractors; and

WHEREAS, Logann Driskell was loved very much by his family and friends and is greatly missed;

NOW, THEREFORE,

Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

➔Section 1. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate the portion of United States Route 127 from milepoint 2.535 to milepoint 5.295 the "Logann Driskell Memorial Highway," and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution, erect appropriate signs denoting this designation.
