

A JOINT RESOLUTION directing the Transportation Cabinet to erect signs on United States Highway 25E in Knox County that proclaim Knox County as the home of 2015 National Junior Olympic Gold Medalists in Gymnastics, Hannah and Reese Farris.

WHEREAS, Hannah and Reese Farris are the daughters of Ronnie Farris of Barbourville, Kentucky; and

WHEREAS, Hannah Farris attends Corbin High School; and

WHEREAS, Reese Farris attends Barbourville Elementary School; and

WHEREAS, in 2015, Hannah and Reese Farris, along with their younger sister, Livy, competed in the AAU Junior Olympics in District, Regional, and State competitions; and

WHEREAS, Hannah and Reese Farris advanced to the National Finals held in Virginia Beach, Virginia in July 2015; and

WHEREAS, competing against athletes from across America, Reese Farris won the Gold Medal in Floor Tumbling and Hannah Farris won the Gold Medals in Floor Tumbling and Double-Mini Trampoline, in their respective age divisions;

NOW, THEREFORE,

Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

➔Section 1. The Transportation Cabinet is hereby directed to honor Hannah and Reese Farris by erecting signs on United States Highway 25E at the Knox County/Laurel County line at and the Knox County/Bell County line that read "Home of 2015 National Junior Olympic Gold Medalists in Gymnastics Hannah and Reese Farris." The signs erected under this section shall remain in place for at least one year from the date of their placement.
