WHEREAS, on October 20, 2015, a house fire claimed the lives of Lori Ann Doppelheuer-Kearney; three of Lori's children; and her neighbor, Larry Randolph Brickles; and

WHEREAS, this honorable body stands in solemn mourning on this day, and asks that all in this Commonwealth keep this family in their prayers as they continue to grieve for those lost in this tragic accident; and

WHEREAS, Lori Ann Doppelheuer-Kearney was the mother of Christopher Kearney, 10 years old; Eagan Hargis, three years old; and Kieran Hargis, 20 months. She was a proud veteran of the United States Marine Corps who served in the Iraq War and the Senior Vice Commander of the Maysville VFW Post No. 2734; and

WHEREAS, Lori Ann Doppelheuer-Kearney was the beloved daughter of Ann Shumate and Bobby D. Doppelheuer (Susan), and is also survived by her fiancé, Chris Hargis; children, Gavin Hargis, Makayla Kearney, and Sara Hargis; brother, Eddy Meek; and sister, Kimberly Doppelheuer; and

WHEREAS, this body today honors Lori Ann Doppelheuer-Kearney for her service to this nation as it mourns her loss as well as the loss of her precious children and her neighbor;

NOW, THEREFORE,

***Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

➔Section 1.
