WHEREAS, Representative Tom Kerr has been a practicing attorney in Covington since 1977. A member of the Kenton, Campbell, Boone County, and Kentucky Bar Associations, he has served on the Pro Bono Panel of the Northern Kentucky Bar Association; and

WHEREAS, Representative Tom Kerr was elected to represent Kentucky House District 64, and has served in the Kentucky House of Representatives since 1986. During his three decades of service to that body, he has worked diligently to honor the best interests of his district and to improve the quality of life for all Kentuckians; and
