**MEASURE'S PURPOSE:** The purpose of the measure is to increase the executive branch agent lobbying registration fee from \$125 to \$275.

**PROVISIONS/MECHANICS:** Section 1 amends KRS 11A.211 to increase the executive branch agent lobbying registration fee to \$275.

Section 2 declares this act an emergency to take effect upon its passage.

**FISCAL EXPLANATION:** The increased fees will have no fiscal impact until FY 17 because the annual registration statement and fees are not due until the last day of July each year.

Since the revenue from registration fees is driven by the number of registered employers or real parties in interest, it is impossible to determine the precise fiscal impact. There were 580 registered employers or real parties in interest in three of the last four fiscal years. If the number of registered employers or real parties in interest remains at 580, then total revenues should increase by \$87,000 annually by increasing the fees from \$125 to \$275.
